## Opening water allocations for Deua Valley users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced available water determinations for Deua Valley water users for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

Domestic and stock, local water utility, unregulated river and aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Deua unregulated and alluvial water sources receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.

Water sources covered by this plan include; Araluen Creek, Bettowynd and Moodong Creeks, Burra Creek, Deua River, Mogendoura Creek, Moruya River, Upper Deua River and Wamban Creek.
