## Opening water allocations for Peel Valley users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced commencing available water determinations for Peel Valley water users for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

In the Peel regulated river water source, local water utility and domestic and stock water access licence holders receive an allocation of 70 per cent of entitlement.

High security water access licence holders in the Peel regulated river water source and its sub categories receive an allocation of 0.50 megalitre per unit share.

General security water access licence holders receive an allocation of 0 megalitre per unit share.

All local water utility and domestic and stock water access licence holders in the Peel unregulated river, Peel alluvium and Peel fractured rock water sources receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement.

In the Peel alluvium water source, aquifer access licence holders receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share, while aquifer (general security) access licence holders receive an allocation of 0.51 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Peel unregulated river water access licence holders will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer water access licence holders in the Peel fractured rock water source also receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share.
