Opening water allocations for Belubula River users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced available water determinations for water users in the Belubula regulated river for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing on 1 July 2019.

Domestic and stock water access licence holders on the regulated Belubula River receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement.

Belubula regulated river high security water access licence holders receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share.

General security water access licence holders will not receive any new allocation, but will have access to account water that has been carried over from the previous water year under the water sharing plan rules.

For the 2019-20 water year, licence holders can access water in their accounts up to a maximum of 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of their entitlement, plus any adjustments for trade.

Supplementary water access licence holders will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

The department will continue to closely monitor the situation and may make subsequent available water determinations for general security licence holders as further water becomes available.
