Opening water allocations for Richmond Valley users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced available water determinations for water users in the Richmond Valley water sources for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

High security water access licence holders in the Richmond regulated water source receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement, while general security water access licence holders also receive 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Local water utility and domestic and stock water access licence holders in the Richmond regulated river receive 100 per cent of entitlement.

All water access licence holders who draw water from the unregulated, alluvial and groundwater water sources covered by the Richmond River area unregulated, regulated and alluvial water sharing plan, receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.
