

Training Program for Wilcannia Community

Training in Construction, Tourism and Hospitality

The WaterNSW Wilcannia Weir project team are working together with TAFE NSW, Regional Enterprise Development Institute (REDI.E) and Murdi Paaki Regional Assembly (MPRA) to package a training program, to start in Wilcannia community in October 2020.

As part of our commitment to the Aboriginal Participation in Construction (APIC) Policy WaterNSW is providing training opportunities for the community. The skills developed in the program can build local capacity to improve future opportunities on other projects and industries in the region.

A short 'Fit for Work' course will kick off the training to prepare participants for the subsequent longer training courses in construction, tourism and hospitality. The first accredited course offered is for Certificates 1 and 2 in Construction. This will be followed by courses in Tourism and Hospitality. Anyone can enroll for these training courses and REDI.E will provide support that is needed.
