The Far North Coast Water Strategy must not rely on Rous's Future Water 2060 project, especially
because that plan doesn't have a holistic approach. It only focusses in a small portion of reality. I think that the Dunoon dam should no longer
be an option in the strategy.

There are so many more ways than dam or groundwater, but they are not taken into consideration. Desalination, water recycling and system improvement to stop waste have proven in other areas to be
very successful.

These options must be prioritised if we have the chance to keep the Channon Gorge as part of the small remains of the Big Scrub. They are habitat of previously endangered species. How can you even think
about not trying to have that?

Please do the right thing and do what is best for our planet!
