This Order is made under section 59(1)(a) of the *Water Management Act 2000*. The object of this Order is to make an available water determination for access licences in the water source identified in Schedule 1 of this Order.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the Available Water Determination Order for the Gwydir Regulated River Water Source 2022 [No. 5].

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the 7th of June 2022.

3 Available water determination

This Order determines the availability of water in relation to the water source specified in Schedule 1, for the categories and subcategories of access licence specified in Schedule 2, on the terms specified in Schedule 2.

Schedule 1 Water Source

This Order applies to the Gwydir Regulated River Water Source as identified in clause 4 of the Water Sharing Plan for the Gwydir Regulated River Water Source 2016.

Schedule 2 Access licences and terms

Each amount specified in Column 2 applies to the adjacent category / subcategory of access licence specified in Column 1.

Regulated river (general security) access licences	1.029 megalitre

Note: This available water determination is in addition to any water allocation credited in accordance with any available water determination made in relation to the water source specified in Schedule 1, for a category or subcategory of access licence specified in Schedule 2, during this water year commencing 1 July 2021.
