Opening water allocations for Tuross Valley users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced available water determinations for Tuross Valley water users for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

Domestic and stock, local water utility, unregulated river and aquifer water access licence holders covered by the Tuross River unregulated and alluvial water sharing plan receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.

Water sources covered by this plan include; Tuross River, Upper Tuross River, Wadbilliga River, Wagonga Inlet Tributaries, Woila Creek, Yowrie Creek, Belimbla Creek, Brou Lake, Bumberry Creek, Bumbo Creek, Coila Lake, Corunna Lake, Gulph Creek, Lake Mummuga, Little and Big Belimbla Creeks, Mellion Creek, Mid Tuross River, Reedy Creek, Swamp Creek, Wandella Creek, Tilba Tilba Lake and Tuross estuary tributaries.
