Project update – June 2022

Water Infrastructure NSW is committed to improving the efficiency and resilience of water management within the Belubula Valley and is continuing to progress with the Final Business Case for the Belubula Water Security Project.

Modelling

Modelling investigations are being undertaken in collaboration with the Department of Planning and Environment's Lachlan Regional Water Strategy team. The results will be used to inform the preferred project options and to guide further technical and on-site investigations. The interim modelling is expected by the end of July 2022, and the team will work with stakeholder groups to share these results when available.

Technical investigations

We are currently seeking Expressions of Interest for technical services required to support the development of the final business case. It is expected the successful service providers will commence both on-site and field investigations from September 2022.

Community and stakeholder engagement

Collaboration and partnership with both Central Tablelands Water and WaterNSW will ensure proposed project activities are aligned and planned effectively.

Landowner and commercial stakeholder engagement is ongoing and we will ensure opportunities are available for all stakeholders and community members to provide input and feedback as the final business case progresses.
