There should be a relationship between water harvesting cost and product use. The water being extracted is Australian water. The first priority is that this water best meets the needs of products that feed, develop, and support Australians, the water that is used to feed, develop of support Non Australian communities, ie, is used to produce an export, should be charged at a higher rate. I am saying there should a differentiation of water fees based on targetted product use. If the product is used for Australians then this water should be cheaper to buy. If the water is used to produce and expeort product, then this should be at a higher fee. I would like to see this higher fee to be signicantly higher. eg 4x higher. The reason for this is that the value of this water must no be judged against the value of Australian flora and fauna, the Australian ecosystem, the cultural value of water, the sustainability of water quality for river communities and importance of water Aboriginal cultural. The events of the global COVID pandemic has highlighted the need for greater capacity to be sef sustaining. The recent bush fire and droughts have highlighted that we cannot ignore that water has a much greater environment value that when we assume the world climate and temperatures are static. Unless Australians put a great priority on maintaining the Autralian ecosystems, flora and fauna, and respect that the next generations deserve the rite to have the same, then water can easily be only seen as a convenience to make money. Another thing that needs to included in the fee calculations is whether the business if wholely, partly of zero Australian owned. The use of water should provide maximum to the Australian people and Australian society. Note I live on the North Coast, but I am focused on all NSW people and communities. We should benefit both locally and and across NSW with commercial water use . I believe this differentiated water fee should be used across Australia. Aboriginal culture emphasises the caring of all country for the benefit of all. There is high importance given to maintaing the country for future generations and a long term view of the country. Short term commercial gain for some is not an Aboriginal cultural focus.
