## Opening water allocations for North Western region users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced available water determinations for the state's North Western region water users for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

Local water utility and domestic and stock water access licence holders covered by the water sharing plan for the Intersecting Streams unregulated and alluvial water source receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement.

Unregulated river and unregulated river (special additional high flow) water access licence holders receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Water sources covered by this plan area include the Mooni River, Narran River, Culgoa River, Warrego River, Paroo River, Yanda Creek, Warrego alluvial and Paroo alluvial.

All categories of water access licence holders covered by the North Western unregulated and fractured rock water sources water sharing plan also receive an allocation of 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Water sources covered by this plan area include the North Western unregulated surface water areas that cover the NSW portion of the Bulloo overflow, Lake Frome, Coopers Creek and Lake Bancannia catchments and the North Western fractured rock groundwater areas of Kanmantoo, Adelaide and Lachlan Fold Belt.
