1. There needs to be a map that shows the jurisdiction of Sydney water in relation to the strategy. The current graphic is too vague and with computerised property systems, surely you can generate an interactive map that addresses this.
2. There are no discussions about any strategic approach to the management or regulation of temporary uses on land adjacent to the water areas or the reservoirs. This may address the current ad-hoc framework which proposed swimming areas in Sydney harbour.
3. Will the monitoring and evaluations raw data and analysis be in the public domain and independently assessed?
