## Opening water allocations for Macleay Valley users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced available water determinations for Macleay Valley water users for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

Domestic and stock, local water utility, unregulated river and aquifer water access licence holders on the Chandler, Dyke, Gara, Georges, Styx, Tia, Yarrawitch, Oakey rivers, Bakers, Blue Mountain, Christmas, Collombatti, Dungay, Euroka, Five Day, Gills Bridge, Green Gully, Hickeys, Mungay, Nulla Nulla, Stockyard creeks, Warbro, Kunderang brooks, Apsley, Chandler, Coastal Mcleay, Macleay gorges, Macleay Valley, Malpas Dam and Salisbury Waters water sources receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer access water licence holders who draw from Coastal Macleay floodplain alluvial groundwater source also receive 1 megalitre per unit share.

Domestic and stock and unregulated river access water licence holders who draw from the Apsley River, Commissioners Waters and Toorumbree Creek water sources, which are also now covered by the Macleay water sharing plan, receive 100 per cent of entitlement.
