Predictions of increasing population need to be closely tied to water availability and critical human needs. Australia needs to be stabilising population growth and moving to a circular economy. 2. Improving environmental health and resilience is critical for the future of water dependent species, healthy communities, recreation and social and cultural benefits. Species threatened with extinction under current water management scenarios will struggle to maintain populations under climate change. The cascading impacts of species extinction must be better recognised so that future opportunities are not destroyed through carelessness. The Murrumbidgee Region contains significant wetlands and habitats covered by international treaties and agreements. These responsibilities must be met and are required under the Federal Water Act and Basin Plan. 3. Aboriginal water rights and access has been a legal requirement under the NSW Water Management Act 2000 that is still outstanding nearly a quarter of a century later. This is reprehensible and must be addressed with great urgency. 4. Agriculture and emerging industries need support to move away from wasteful water practices such as flood irrigation. Intensive permanent plantings have caused increased competition for capped water entitlement. The focus on understanding why water use is not to full level of availability must examine the basis of setting water sharing plan limits. We consider that

	they have been set too high and are unachievable within the increasing variability of climate extremes. Long term annual average use is not the best indicator. In wet seasons water entitlement is not used, in dry seasons the water is not available for use.
